#### Dear friends,

The street where we live is starting to light up. As you drive along you can see sparkling Christmas trees lighting up front windows, twinkling lights decorating homes and even tinsel wound around street sign poles. These add to the sense of joyful anticipation of Christmas.

In comparison to Christmas, Advent can sometimes be overlooked. However, Advent offers us an opportunity to reflect more comprehensively on what the birth of Jesus really means. Not just a baby in a manger, but the promised Messiah, who gave his life, rose again defeating sin and death and has promised to return.

When life is going smoothly you may be tempted to modify the prayer 'Come Lord Jesus Come' to 'Come Lord Jesus Come, but not yet because I am really looking forward to.....'.

But for those who are experiencing grief and hardship, the prayer might echo the longings of their heart. Do you pray this prayer? Do you long for Jesus' return? Longing for Jesus' return isn't only contingent on our personal life circumstances, it comes from longing 'that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue acknowledge that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.' (Philippians 2:10–11)

This Advent, consider a daily devotional resource that will draw you closer to God through Jesus and grow this longing within your heart and mind.





May this longing overflow into our life, faith and hope that we will shine in the world 'like stars in the sky as we hold firmly to the word of life'. (Philippians 2:15-16). May we shine brighter than the most wonderful of Christmas light displays.
