

## **Sessions:**

Our playgroups run on Wednesday and Thursday mornings between 10:00 and 11:30 am, during school terms.

## **Fees:**

Fees may be paid yearly or by term. Payment is due at the start of the year/term.

## **What does our sessions look like?**

Playgroup is a time for you to spend with your child/ren in a safe and welcoming environment. Playgroup uses an explorational play model, where the children have multiple options to be involved.

This helps to develop their social skills and motor pathways.

Each week we have activities, such as puzzles, dress ups, craft and outdoor play. We then gather together and sing some songs, read a book and enjoy a snack. As this is a playgroup, as opposed to a child care service, you are expected to attend the group and to supervise your child/ren.

### **Child safety:**

Our playgroups are run by a team of volunteers. Each volunteer has completed our Child Safe training and has obtained a Police Check and a Working With Children Check.

### **Community:**

We love to get to know and support one another at GWAC playgroups. As part of our community, we share morning tea together. This is BYO for your own child. For adults we make a roster so we can share together. A range of teas and coffee is supplied.

Spark is our primary-school aged ministry. Spark runs during our Sunday 10:30am and 5:00pm services. The kids sign in before the service starts and then join their families for a time of worship in song. They then come out with their leaders for around 45 minutes. During this time we look at the Bible, play games and do other activities together. Special 'SPARK' events such as holiday programs and gatherings also take place from time to time.



We meet on Friday evenings (7:00–9:00pm) for worship, community and mission. Smaller age-based groups that provide a place of deep connection and belonging alternate with larger scale worship and outreach nights that provide a sense of energy and wider social connection. Ignite is a supportive community where everyone is welcome!
